Township Park

We will be opening and closing the gate until our camera system is installed because last summer there was \$2500 damage caused by a side-by-side and again on January 2, 2021 a truck created a similar amount of damage on the soccer field. We would like to catch the people responsible to get restitution. All of us tax payers would rather see that money be spent on roads and cleaning ditches. We are keeping the track plowed for those that enjoy walking.

2021 Road Projects

We will be paving ½ mile of Jefferson South of Townline Road and graveling Curtis Road East of Jefferson. We also will be working on Townline Road between Swede and Jefferson with ditching and additional gravel. (Midland County Road Commission has given us a significant discount on this project.

Our focus is going to be roads like Townline Road where school buses and emergency vehicles have a difficult time traveling during certain times of the year.
